Goodman Supply expanding in Frisco

A Frisco wholesale plumbing company is expanding its operations in Frisco. **Goodman Supply** will spend about \$225,000 to add 1,500 square feet to its 2,500-square-foot showroom next month.

Business is up about 5 percent up, said Jeffrey Goodman, general manager for Goodman Supply. His company has found success, he says, by avoiding work on low-end residential properties, which have been more affected by the mortgage credit crunch.

"We're the only ones out in Frisco doing this kind of thing," Goodman said. "We're going to be the only ones with a luxury type of business as well."

Skanadario by Goodman Supply is the decorative plumbing and hardware showroom arm of Goodman Supply, founded in downtown Dallas in 1946. Goodman opened a second location with warehouse and office facilities in Frisco in 2000.

In 2004, Goodman sold that site to Frisco's new Pizza Hut Park stadium and moved to its current location at 9750 John W. Elliott D. In January 2005, Goodman opened the Skanadario Gallery Showroom. It features porcelain, glass, wood, bronze, copper and granite. Decorative plumbing products include fixtures like sinks, toilets and jetted tubs. It also includes a line of hardware.
