Longtime Dallas business grand opens upscale kitchen appliance gallery

Goodman Supply expands Skanadario Showroom in January

(FRISCO, TX – Dec. 18, 2007) – One of the Metroplex’ oldest wholesale plumbing operations will open the expansion of its Frisco showroom in January.

Goodman Supply Company, founded in Dallas in 1946, announced plans to expand its Skanadario Gallery Showroom at its Frisco location. The announcement was made by Jeffrey Goodman, the third generation of the Goodman family in the business.

Skanadario by Goodman Supply is the decorative plumbing and hardware showroom division of Goodman Supply. The expansion launches Skanadario’s entry into the high-end luxury appliance business.

Harold Goodman founded the firm on South Lamar in downtown Dallas in 1946 and was a key player in the Dallas real estate boom following World War II. His son Steve Goodman took over the business in the ‘70s and in 2003 grandson Jeffrey Goodman joined as general manager.

Goodman Supply opened a second wholesale location with warehouse and office facilities in Frisco in 2000. In 2004 Goodman sold that site to Frisco’s new Pizza Hut Park stadium and moved to its current location at 9750 John W. Elliott Dr. just off Main Street between Preston Road and the Dallas North Tollway. In January 2005, Goodman opened the Skanadario Gallery Showroom.

Skanadario’s showroom is an American Standard gallery showroom, displaying the most comprehensive selection of American Standard Companies’ kitchen and bath products including its Jado and Porcher brands. Additionally the showroom carries international designer lines and local products from Texas-based artisans and companies.

“Skanadario is the Iroquois word for ‘beautiful water,’ perfect nomenclature for a resource with some of the most beautiful decorative plumbing and hardware in the industry,” says Jeffrey Goodman.

The showroom features a wide range of materials – porcelain, glass, wood, bronze, copper, granite, onyx, marble, travertine and soapstone. Decorative plumbing products include fixtures such as sinks, toilets and jetted tubs; faucets for kitchens, bathrooms and shower systems; and specialty items such as bathroom furniture and cabinetry, steam and sauna units, and water heaters, chillers and filters.

The hardware product line consists of bathroom accessories, cabinet pulls, and door hardware from Baldwin, Top Knobs and other manufacturers. Additional products range from towel warmers and medicine cabinets to under-tile heaters and Caesarstone quartz countertops.

The new appliance showroom features luxury appliances from Viking, Miele, Thermador, and Bosch. Additional lines including Vent-A-Hood, U-Line, Asko, Gaggenau, and Hoshizaki.

The showroom caters to custom homebuilders, interior designers, architects, remodelers, and discerning homeowners. “We expanded into luxury appliances due to customer requests and demand,” explained Mr. Goodman. “There’s no other showroom like it in Frisco or Collin County. We’re very excited about this opportunity.”

The appliance showroom adds 1,500 square feet to Skanadario’s current 2,500 square feet of displays. The expansion features working displays of Miele’s Master Chef oven as well as its Steam Oven, Speed Cook Oven, and built-in coffee maker.

“Goodman Supply has long been known for outstanding service and attention to detail as well as extensive product knowledge,” says Jeffrey Goodman. “Our launch of this showroom expansion takes us to the next level with one of the most complete product offerings in the southwest.”
